For Jennifer Brown and her family, 1993 was a difficult and life-changing year. Along with her dad, Ronnie, and younger brother, Joey, Jennifer was involved in a serious automobile accident in the summer of 1993. Jennifer was six at the time of the accident. Although the children were not seriously injured, Ronnie suffered a spinal cord injury that would forever change their lives. The injury resulted in a long rehabilitation process for Ronnie at BHRI.

In the aftermath of the accident, Jennifer would accompany her dad to physical and occupational therapy sessions at BHRI. It was at this young age that Jennifer began to dream of a life helping others as a healthcare professional, specifically in a field of rehabilitation therapy. Healthcare was a family affair at the Brown house. Her dad, Ronnie, has worked for Baptist Health since 1988. He has worked as an Orderly, Nursing Assistant, RN, and is currently working at BHRI as a Nurse Educator. Jennifer’s mom, Suzette, has been a radiological technician for Baptist Health for 28 years and is currently working at BHMC-NLR.

As a 2009 graduate of the BHSLR-School of Occupational Therapy Assistant, Jennifer has accomplished her goal of becoming a healthcare professional with enthusiasm and excellence.
