2. A digital photo to be included as a separate file, labeled accordingly to match the story.
3. The deadline date for submission is **December 19, 2011**.

The Conference Planning Committee will select one school recipient in early January 2012, and the winning institution will be immediately advised of its selection. The institution's community service efforts will be recognized with an award to be presented during the Conference. Additionally, one institutional representative will be ABHES' guest for the conference and will receive a complementary conference registration and a \$500 donation.
