Subject: Volunteers – Program Advisory Committee – Radiologic Technology/Radiography

The Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (ABHES or the Commission) is in the process of naming a Program Advisory Committee in the academic discipline of Radiologic Technology/Radiography (RT). The purpose of the adhoc Committee is to review and develop program-specific standards and requirements as related to RT curricula, including applicable credentialing requirements. Subsequent to this review, ABHES will then introduce new program-specific standards in the RT discipline. The Program Advisory Committee will be comprised of three to five members, including Commission staff representatives.

Interested individuals to serve on the Program Advisory Committee must meet the following criteria:

- Serve as a program director or didactic faculty member for a Radiologic Technology/Radiography program either institutionally or programmatically accredited by an agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education or by the Council on Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA).
- Possess a minimum of five (5) years as program director or didactic faculty member of a Radiologic Technology/Radiography program, as described above, including experience in curriculum development.
- Possess accreditation experience as an on-site evaluator (peer-review) or other administrative accreditation experience on behalf of an accreditation agency recognized by the U.S. Secretary of Education or by the Council on Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA).
- Hold a current credential in the field of Radiologic Technology/Radiography or similar program from a nationally recognized and accredited credentialing agency.

Qualified individuals must submit a one-page cover letter detailing interest; expertise; experience level; and current level of involvement in the RT academic discipline. Please include a current resume or curriculum vitae.

Please be advised that positions are limited and only those most qualified will be selected. Program Advisory Committee involvement will include periodic telephone conferences and may involve at least one in-person meeting. Related travel expenses, as applicable, and a nominal honorarium will be provided by the Commission.
